



Example glossary with pictures

Used ¶ formats and their pupose

Format	Purpose
gl-glossary-entry	Run-in with highligh
gp-glossary-w-picture	2-column glossary text
gnp-glossary-no-picture	Glossary entry spanning both columns in case no picture is available
ga-glossary-anchor	Anchoring the picture frame (At Insertion Point)
gb-glossary-balancer	¶ after the glossary anchor, balances the columns
fc-figure-caption	right adjusted to be close to the picture

Master pages

There are two master pages: R-glossary and L-glossary, which are automatically assigned with **Format > Page Layout > Apply Master Pages** (be means of the table on the reference pages).

Tables

Table style glossary is used as a layout aid only, not for tabular data.

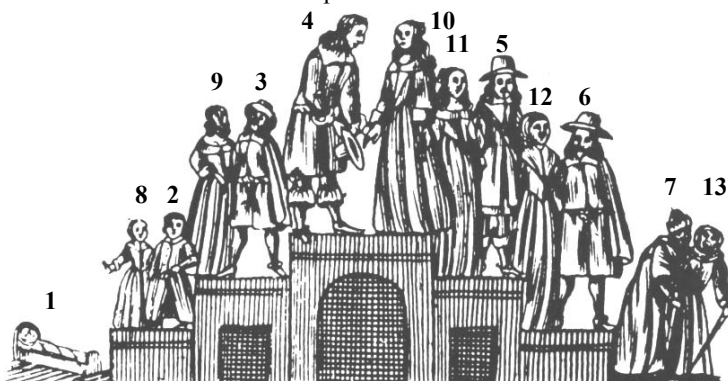
