Any ¶-format used in the TOC file must not have a 'TOC' in its name - it will be removed when the TOC refreshed. Hence the heading on the next page is format 'z1-head' and not '1heading-noTOC'.

The figure table provides 2 rows and columns to allow easy resizing with the mouse. In a 1-cell table this is not possible. The cell margin left is set to 0 to allow images to align with the text column.

Table 3: Normal-h-rules

In the Normal-h-rules table the left cell margin is 0. Thus the contents of the first column aligns with the general text column.


Table 4: Normal-hv-rules

In the Normal-hv-rules table the left border aligns with the text column.

In the Wide-h-rules table the left cell margin is 0. Thus the contents of the first column aligns with the left margin.

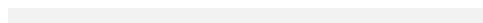

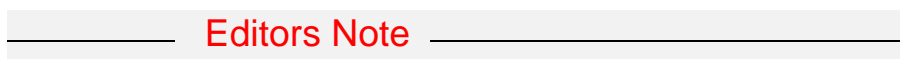
